#### **COMMITTEE FOR MINISTRY AMONGST DEAF AND DISABLED PEOPLE**

*The Ven. Cherry Vann, Archdeacon of Rochdale (Manchester) to move:*

"That this Synod, mindful of the Gospel imperative to include all people in the one Body of Christ, and particularly those who are marginalised,

- (a) affirm the valued place of Deaf and disabled Christians;
- (b) welcome the unique gifts, insights and contributions that Deaf and disabled people bring to the Church; and
- (c) in the light of the budget cut for CMDDP (the Archbishops' Council's Committee for Ministry Amongst Deaf and Disabled

People) from £90K to £10K, call on the Archbishops' Council, in preparing its next budget, to increase that provision to £40K, so that the work to encourage and strengthen the participation of Deaf people and people with disabilities in the life and witness of the Church may continue and develop in new and creative ways.”
